The International Tutor Training Certification Program

- * Is sponsored by the College Reading and Learning Association
- * Began in 1989
- * Certifies programs at three levels
- * Requires a minimum of 10 hours of training and 25 hours of tutoring experience for each certification level
- * Costs effective July 1, 2005, application fees will be as follows: 1 level \$100; 2 levels: \$150; 3 levels: \$200
- * Provides professional standards for tutor training
- * Rewards tutors
- * Establishes credibility for tutoring programs
- * Is endorsed by the National Association for Developmental Education (NADE), and Commission XVI, Academic Support in Higher Education, of the American College Personnel Association (ACPA), and the national Council of Learning Assistance and Developmental Education Associations (CLADEA).
- * Has filled thousands of requests for information and application packets.
- * Over 650 programs are currently certified in the United States and a few other countries.
- * Produced a handbook in 1995 entitled The College Reading and Learning Association's *Tutor Training Handbook* which is available for \$20
